**Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref GestDem No 2022/0113**

We refer to your email dated 5 January 2022 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 7 January 2022 under the above-mentioned reference number.

We further refer to our email dated 28 January 2022 extending the time limit for responding to your request pursuant to Article 7(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001<sup>1</sup>.

In your request, you ask on the basis of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, access to:

*A list of all Consignors and/or Exporters of food of non-animal origin identified by the TARIC codes "20029091" and/or "20029031" shipped from China to Italy between 30/6/2021 and the most recent data available at the time of your response. For each Consignor/Exporter please indicate the following information:-Consignees/Importers-Shipping dates-Weight (if available).*

We enclose a copy of the data requested.

Please note that the data extracted originate from the Member State's authorities, which have been consulted, in accordance with Article 4(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001. Please note also that the data are extracted from the Common Health Entry Documents (CHED) that are saved in the TRACES system. The use of TRACES for the commodities mentioned in your request is not mandatory. Therefore, the attached list is probably not exhaustive. Other consignments, not registered in TRACES, may have been shipped.

Please also note that documents with data originating from third parties are disclosed to you based on Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001. However, this disclosure is without prejudice to the rules on intellectual property, which may limit your right to reproduce or
