	thanked for the opportunity to give an early information and background explanation about the Shell's decision to withdraw from Russian oil and gas, explained that Shell would stop any involvement with investment in Russian hydrocarbons, from oil to gas and LNG, in a phased manner. It would also shut down operations in Russia, for service stations or aviation fuels. In mentioned that public reactions to the decision to purchase a cargo of Russian crude oil to be refined had been a wake up call, and that the company would align with the spirit of phasing out from Russian fossil exports. Mr Grassi welcomed the decision and express appreciation for Shell's courtesy in giving a detailed and early information about their decision. He noted that other companies had or were taking similar decisions and hoped that this would lead to a swift move away from Russian fossil exports and reduction of the export revenues used to fund the illegal and brutal war of aggression against Ukraine.
