in Italy we gave to our official control officer the information on stop the sale of food supplements containing CBD on the basis of their novel food status.

I think that we need a little bit of more clarity regarding the CBD case and in general the Cannabis derivatives use.

I do not think honestly that there was an HOC of other parts of the Cannabis with the exception of seeds before 1997, certainly not for CBD.

So I think that we can take action on the basis of novel food regulation at least for CBD.
