

Slovenia would like to inform its EU partners that the 13th International Export Control Conference titled 'Partnership in Non-proliferation' will be held in Portorož, Slovenia, from 7 to 9 May 2012. The Conference will formally open on Monday, 7 May 2012, and conclude on Wednesday, 9 May 2012. Arrangements for the conference venue are being finalised, and will be communicated in the welcome e-mail sent to all delegation members. Transfer from Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport to Portorož and back will be arranged for all participants.
