

HIGH-LEVEL ROUNDTABLE “BUILDING TRUST FOR EHDS”

23 November 2021

1. Steering note

You have been invited by DIGITALEUROPE to attend a high-level roundtable ‘building trust for the EHDS’. DIGITALEUROPE is a trade association representing digitally transforming industries in Europe. A number of senior business executives from large companies have joined DIGITALEUROPE’s new Executive Council for Health and this roundtable is part of this new Council.

The event is organised on 23 November under Chatham House rules.

DIGITALEUROPE is participating to the eHealth Stakeholder Group invited by the Commission (CNECT and SANTE) to collaborate on five important challenges to promote Acceptance of the European Health Data Space.

- Working group 1: Which concrete solutions do we identify and actions could we take, to promote cross-border access to health data and interoperability?
- Working group 2: Which concrete solutions do we identify and actions could we take, to promote the cross-border re-use of health data for research and policy-making?
- Working group 3: Which concrete solutions do we identify and actions could we take, to promote cross-border uptake of digital health services and products?
- Working group 4: Which concrete solutions do we identify and actions could we take, to promote cross-border uptake of AI for health care?
- Working group 5: Which concrete solutions do we identify and actions could we take, to promote the sharing of health data between public and private partners?

These five working groups were formed, led by different stakeholders (DIGITALEUROPE did not lead any working group but was involved in the groups), which presented their solutions and suggested actions at a webinar on September 10.
