& follow-up	February 2022 in Baku. The TAP Consortium reported on the upscale potential of the Trans-Adriatic Pipeline (TAP) and issues in relation to the Western Balkans.
	 Details: Stefano Grassi (SG) inquired more information on the market test and possible additional demand in IT and EL. (LS) provided details on the binding market test procedure in July 2022. He stressed the importance of the meeting in Baku LS also reiterated the invitation to a conference in Split on the Ionian-Adriatic Pipeline (IAP) project on 18 January. As regards the Western Balkans, he mentioned the relevance of natural gas for a possible coal—to-gas switch in the region. LS suggested that the TAP expansion and extension to the Western Balkans could happen gradually in line with demand. LS also suggested that the TAP Consortium is already testing how TAP's infrastructure could be made hydrogen-compatible in future and asked for political
	 support to convince shippers to switch to hydrogen as soon as it is available in sufficient quantities. SG thanked the TAP Consortium for the information and recalled ENER's position that TAP's possible expansion or extension would primarily need to be market-driven. He also enumerated possible conditions for new gas infrastructure in the Western Balkans and reiterated the importance of addressing urgently methane emissions.
