  - For the applicant No 10 "EFE", the declaration on the honour "DoH" should be signed by the legal representative(s) mentioned on your application form: there was a discrepancy between the application form and the declaration on the honour.
  - For the applicants No 3 "ANSA" and No 13 "MIA", they should make sure their electronic signatures are valid and qualified within the meaning of Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 (eIDAS Regulation) **or** provide blue ink handwritten signed versions. Current versions of DoH do not pass the validation tool as referred in the call and DoH template provided.
