

BTO – ENISA call with ZTE 11.3.22

Main points:

ZTE founded 1985 listed on Chinese and Hong Kong stock exchanges, not linked to government, 3000 employees in Europe, 1bn revenue in Europe and would like to expand. Cybersecurity highly important. And top priority. They have CC certificate 3+ level for whole product solutions and NESAS-confirm. Interested in being part of ENISA work groups on 5G and Bongiorno positioned himself as ad personum expert candidate. Also interested on other ways to cooperate including IOT future schemes.

ENISA stressed its role within the certification process, the process and timing of the calls for the working groups, the process of selection and the importance of the implementation and decisions of the Member States. ENISA also provided a general update of the work on the current schemes, and the possibilities of the EU's internal market. ENISA highlighted the role of the Agency and the role of the Commission and the MS in cybersecurity certification.

ZTE suggested further such calls in the future; ENISA responded that it was generally open.
