	<p>Enagas asked the Commission how the company could help the Commission in the current security of supply crisis. Enagas owns 3 underground storage capacities and 6 LNG terminals with 20bcm of spare capacity. They receive supply from 9 countries with the US (37%) and Algeria (27%) as main suppliers.</p> <p>Enagas informed the Commission about the current situation of deliveries from Algeria and the issue concerning the end of flows through Maghreb-Europe gas pipeline. Enagas also informed the Commission about the gas flows ES-FR, through the 7 bcm existing interconnection. Enagas presented their plans for increasing the interconnection of the Iberian Peninsula with the rest of Europe via a hydrogen pipeline (that could transport 2 mll tons of hydrogen in a year, as well as the progress made in creating the third gas interconnector between ES and PT.</p> <p>Finally, Enagas and Commission discussed the Hydrogen and gas package proposed by the Commission in December 2021. Enagas welcomed the Commission proposal of favouring ownership unbundling for hydrogen. Enagas has created in a new company: ENAGAS RES, without control in the projects where they participate, as well as another company called ENAGAS H2 INFRASTRUCTURE, which is unbundled from gas TSO operations and which is expected to participate in the H2 market.</p>
