Dear Madam,

I refer to your e-mail dated 13 July 2022, clarified on 26 July 2022, in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 13 July 2022 under the above-mentioned reference number.

Your request access to “*all documents in the possession of the D.G. of Home and Migration Affairs, that contain the two phrases "Copyright AudienceOne" and "Used for training purposes", which have been used for purposes of training by AudienceOne or otherwise, for the time period between November 2020 and today*”.

I regret to inform you that DG HOME does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by DG HOME, my services are not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
