ICMPD presented 70 recommendations for the new EU leadership at our recent Vienna Migration Conference to which we would be delighted to welcome you next year for its 5th edition.


ICMPD, with its 17 current Member States and soon to be 19 (the Netherlands and Germany are in the process of joining the organisation), remains committed to its three main strands of action:

- a) ICMPD provides policy relevant insights and carries out research on migration issues;
- b) ICMPD believes in the need for political dialogue on migration and facilitates all the major dialogues between the EU and third countries (Valletta with Rabat and Khartoum Processes; Budapest Process; Prague Process);
- c) ICMPD carries out capacity building activities in all areas of migration such as a comprehensive portfolio on migration management in Turkey; border management in

North Africa, including important procurement, but also support for the implementation of pilot projects on legal migration or diaspora cooperation.

As you are perfectly aware, migration has a huge divisive and disruptive potential. ICMPD, as the regional European migration organisation, always strives to find pragmatic and inclusive approaches both at political and operational levels, and Dr. Spindelegger would look forward to discussing with you in person ICMPD's recommendations, new initiatives and ways of cooperation.
