| <b>Summary</b>      | <p>GD4S brings together the seven largest DSOs in France (GRDF), Greece (EdaThess), Italy (Itaigas), Ireland (Gas Networks Ireland), Portugal (Galp Gas Natural Distribuicao), Spain (Nedgia) and Romania (Distrigas Sud Retele).</p> <p>The meeting served to GD4S to introduce to the Commissioner the new President of GD4S, Mr de Carreras, and the content of the Charter that GD4S has adopted on 18 February 2022, setting their approach to sustainability.</p> <p>The Charter is based on three pillars: Environmental, Social and Governance. Most notably on energy, the environmental pillar foresees:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Reduction of GHG and CH4 emissions and improvement of energy efficiency.</li> <li>- Integration of IC and RES gases in the distribution grids.</li> </ul> <p>The meeting also served to exchange views on the work to support biomethane and clean gas from municipal waste and waste waters, which is one of the areas where the Commission has proposed to take action within the framework of REPowerEU.</p> |
