Dear Mr Carpentier,

I would like to thank you for your request for access to documents, which the EEAS has examined in the framework of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.<sup>1</sup>

Following your request, we have searched for the *“the list of aircrafts which flew a mission in the frame of EUNAVFOR MED: 29/03/2022; 15/09/2021; 14/09/2021; 24/08/2021; 11/06/2021; 21/01/2021; 19/05/2019; 01/06/2019; 16/05/2019; 11/05/2019; 08/05/2019; 27/08/2018. For each of those flights a KML, CSV or JSON path of the flight if it exists, or at least, the time and place of liftoff and touchdown, and the area in which the flight took place. Also, reports for those flights”*, in the EEAS filing systems and documents management databases.

I regret to inform you that no documents matching your request have been identified.

The information you are looking for is of operational character and might be held by EU NAVFOR MED. Therefore, you might wish to contact directly the military operation. Please note that EUNAVFOR MED is a separate and independent entity with the operational headquarters in Rome. The EEAS has no access to document management system or their databases.
