  - o Next stage: drafting content, expert meetings in September
  - o Focus on PSR, not food systems
  - o Process: MS and COM busy with CAP plans.
  - o Norway will follow closely, F2F, costs for producers and consumers
  - o Latvia: open attitude on questionnaires, various units in one Ministry, interested as own country review some years back, request to meet MS and team (FAQ offered by Secretariat)
  - o US: looking forward to UNFSS coalition SPG, comments provided at March APM
