## Subject: Your application for access to documents – Case 2022/6075

We refer to your e-mail dated 25 October 2022 addressed to DG TRADE in which you make a request for access to documents, registered under the above-mentioned reference number. Your request was re-attributed to us on 25 November 2022.

You request access to: "All documents related to import of tobacco from Malawi by Scandinavian Tobacco Group in Denmark, Mac Baren Tobacco Company in Denmark, Philip Morris International in Poland, Japan Tobacco International in Poland and British American Tobacco in Poland between January 2018 and October 2020."

We regret to inform you that DG Taxation and Customs union (DG TAXUD) does not hold such documents.
