We refer to your e-mail of 12/02/2023 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 12/02/2023 under the above mentioned reference number.

The description given in your application does not enable us to identify concrete documents, which would correspond to your request.

Indeed the project number **T05-EUTF-SAH-REG-04** refers to the project GAR-SI Sahel, Groupe d'Actions Rapides – Surveillance Intervention which is a multicountry programme implemented by FIIAPP in link with Governmental Authorities in the countries of intervention. As such not all documentations is held by the EC.

As such, we would be grateful if you could please specify what do you mean by “In-depth Guidelines/minutes of meetings on how to carry out the activities generically indicated in the Action Documents of projects”. What are the activities you are referring to, in which country and implemented by who?

You are also requesting “monitoring reports on performed activities”. We would also be grateful if you could also clarify which activities are you referring to, in which country?

We therefore invite you, in accordance with Article 6(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents, to provide us with **more detailed information on the documents you request**.
