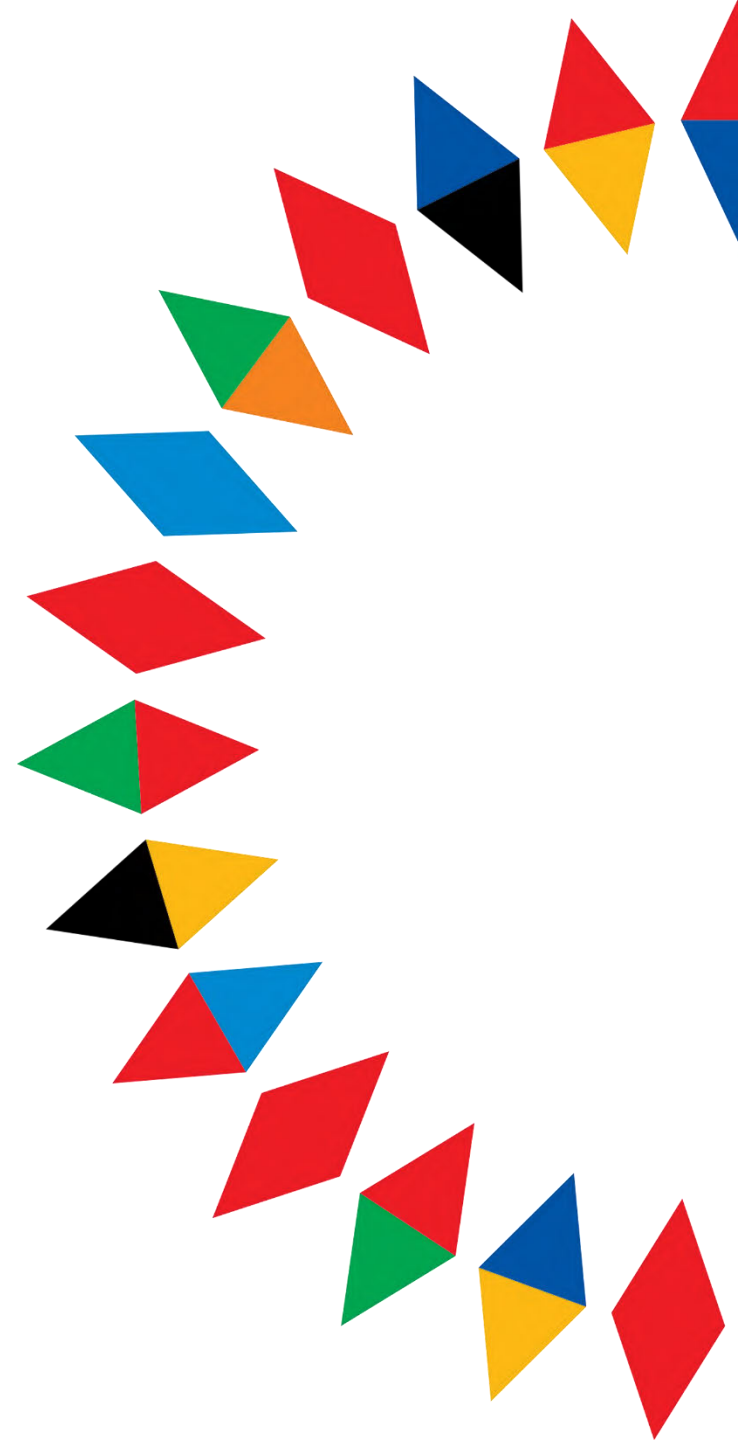

Preparation of operating rules - Art. 70i

Art. 70i (1a)

Participants: Member States, sector concerned, non-governmental organisations promoting environmental protection and Commission

Art. 70i (1a)
(a) – (c)

Exchange of information: Performance of installations/techniques, monitoring, cross-media effects, technical/economical viability ⇒ Identification of BAT

Art. 70i (1)

Draft of operating rules (consistent with BAT): emission/performance limit values and other measures. Nature, type, size, density and pasture system taken into account. Limits may not be established for certain types of farms (very small, organic etc.)

Art. 70i
(2) and (3)

Adoption and implementation: Adoption via implementing act 24 months after the entry into force of IED, 48 months for implementation.
