Your Excellency,

A complete¹ version of the Hungarian BMVI programme was formally submitted via SFC2021 on 19 April 2022. In accordance with Article 23(1) and (2) Common Provisions Regulation², the Commission has assessed the programme and has made some observations. These observations are set out in the annex.

We would like to ask your authorities to consider these observations and revise the programme accordingly, as well as to provide additional information wherever requested. Please bear in mind that, in accordance with Article 3 Common Provisions Regulation, where a time limit is set for an action by the Commission, that time limit is suspended from the day following the date on which the Commission sends its observations or a request for revised documents to the Member State and until the Member State responds to it.
