- (19) The Commission takes note that the horizontal enabling condition 3 (HEC 3) is assessed by Hungary as not fulfilled and no information about mechanisms to ensure compliance with the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union ('the Charter') is provided in the BMVI programme.

Accordingly, the Commission does not have sufficient information to assess the fulfilment of the HEC 3 *'Effective application and implementation of the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights'*.

The Commission formulated observations in relation to the Economic Development and Innovation Operational Programme Plus (CCI: 2021HU16FFPR001) with a letter dated 27 April 2022 (*ref. Ares(2022)3275395*) to which Hungary has not replied. The Commission invites the Hungarian authorities to take into account the relevant parts of the above observations while working on the assessment and justification for the fulfilment of the HEC 3 in the context of the BMVI programme.
