We refer to your request of 10 March 2023 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered under the reference number above.

1. Scope of your request

In your application, based on Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001¹, you requested access to:

- 'The text messages exchanged between Commission President Ursula von der Leyen and the CEO of Pfizer Albert Bourla in the months leading up to the signing of the third COVID-19 vaccine contract with Pfizer/BioNTech, as described here.'
- You also requested 'all available meta-data relating to the text messages, including but not limited to, the devices and applications used to exchange messages, the number of messages sent by each side, the times and dates of the messages, and any locational data associated with the messages.'

2. Identification and assessment of relevant documents

We regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.
