EMN is a non-profit Network composed of the most important European slaughtering industries involved in the slaughtering and processing of beef, pork, lamb and poultry meat.

EMN members are  the following European industries leader in slaughtering and meat processing: Danish Crown, Dawn Meats Group, El Pozo, HK Scan, Vion Food Group, Westfleisch, Sokolow, Belgian Pork Group, Tönnies Lebensmittel.

The purpose of EMN is:

- to strengthen the long term position of the European meat sector;
- to contribute to the improvement of the basis for political decisions affecting the meat sector's long term framework by means of accomplishing or funding strategic, economical and policy studies;
- to increase the influence of the Members on EU and international policy decisions relevant to the European meat sector;
- to create a forum for discussions on developments in relation to the regulatory status of meat and meat products within the European Union and in relation to third countries;
- to create a forum for discussions on technical and other similar developments within the meat industry and in relation to other relevant economic sectors.

Since 2004, EMN members meet regularly with Commissioners and high-level EU officials and MEPs, in order to discuss the intentions and the commitments towards important subjects that might have consequences on the meat sector.
