Dear Mr Comarow,

Thank you for your emails of 19 November and 12 December, the latter received on 15 December 2014, in which you apply for access to any and all information related to the certification or attempted certification of the Tangara TC-360 aircraft by Socata in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145 of 31 May 2001, p. 43). We apologise for the delayed response.

The scope of Regulation (EC) 1049/2001 was extended to documents held by the European Aviation Safety Agency by Art. 58 para. 1 of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC (OJ L 79 of 19.3.2008. p.1).

Please kindly note, that according to our knowledge the aircraft was certified as SOCATA GA7 "Cougar" by the French Direction générale de l'aviation civile (DGAC France) in 1997, and by virtue of Art. 3 of Regulation (EU) No 748/2014¹ this type-certificate shall be deemed as an EASA typecertificate. Please find that French Type Certificate Data Sheet enclosed to this letter.

In addition to that, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has also issued a type-certificate to SOCATA GA-7 "Cougar" that you can find under:
