The handling of your request involves the assessment of a very voluminous set of documents to be analysed in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of Regulation 1049/2001. It is therefore proving very burdensome and hard to manage for our services to carry out this task without a reasonable narrowing of the scope of your request.

Based on this we would kindly ask you to consider narrowing the scope of your request, so as to reduce it to a more manageable amount of documents. In particular, we would

like to ask for

- the specification of the concrete, limited number of stakeholders in which you are

interested (instead of using the term 'stakeholders') e.g. names of organizations, and

- to specify more concretely those limited number of topics in which you are interested in (instead of referring to all the topics that are in the Commissioner's current portfolio) e.g.
