**Subject:    Agreement on cooperation under Rule 50 as regards the proposal

Dear Mr Lehne,


We are glad to inform you that the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Food Safety (ENVI) and the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (ITRE) have found an agreement regarding their cooperation under Rule 50 on the above-mentioned proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 98/70/EC relating to the quality of petrol and diesel fuels and amending Directive 2009/28/EC on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources.

Under the agreement, the two Committees will have joint competences for the entire proposal. In a spirit of close cooperation, the Rapporteur from each Committee will be invited to the other Committee's Shadows meetings and receive all related documents. The ITRE Rapporteur will take part in trilogue meetings, and inter-institutional negotiations will not start before a vote in Plenary on the report has taken place.

The two Rapporteurs have also agreed upon a timetable for the adoption in the respective Committees, according to which the ITRE opinion will be adopted in June 2013 and the ENVI report will be adopted in July 2013.

We trust that this agreement will enable our committees to cooperate in a constructive way.
