Subject: Meeting with AmCham on endocrine disruptors, 25.6.2015; conclusions

Conclusions:

The meeting had been requested by the AmCham to present their views on the dossier "defining criteria for endocrine-disrupting substances (ED)". The meeting lasted approximately 50 minutes.

The visitors stressed the importance of the right methodology to be applied in the screening of substances in the context of the impact assessment. In this context they queried how observations related to the mode of action in animals would be extrapolated for humans. I explained that the matter was with DG JRC and SANTE.

The visitors considered that, generally the process has become more transparent. They also welcomed the fact that the DG *chef de file*, DG SANTE, has increased the human resources dedicated to this dossier. The participants agreed that the interim criteria that currently apply provide for a strict cut-off.

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
