In particular, we refer to the part of your request asking for access to "any study, impact assessment, forecast, paper or other document - commissioned or authored by any part of the European Commission or received from third parties (lobby group, NGO, academic, consultant, or other) - that assesses the impact of gmo food-labelling on the EU food industries in any particular member state(s) - especially in reference to and in the context of the TTIP negotiations", which was assigned to the Directorate-General for Health and Food Safety and registered under the abovementioned reference number on 9 November 2016.
