I am writing on behalf of CropLife America, which represents the manufacturers and distributors of pesticide products in the United States.

We understand that you have not yet received a copy of the joint position paper CropLife America (CLA) and the European Crop Protection Association (ECPA) issued recently, and which we (CLA) sent to the US negotiators in advance of the fourth round of TTIP negotiations.

We sincerely apologise and hope you will accept a copy. Please find attached our cover letter addressed to both EU and US trade negotiators, the summary document, and more detailed outline of our position.

We are also attaching a copy of the trade impact assessment CropLife America conducted to examine the impact on trade should the import MRL's for products default to 0.01mg/kg. This assumption was tested for pesticides categorized as endocrine disrupters using the first set of criteria proposed by DG ENV, and the UK CRD report on same. (click [here](#) for this report)
