## Dear Mr Wuttke

I am writing in reference to your letter of September 2015 concerning market access for European-based law firms in China under the EU-China Comprehensive Agreement on Investment.

I want to thank you for drawing our attention to the difficulties European law firms are faced with when investing and operating in China. In this regard, I would like to reassure you that market access and improvement of the regulatory environment for EU investors in China is amongst the EU's key priorities for these negotiations.
