She had found JUST/JRC study on data protection privacy seals on the internet and was wondering when COM would start implementation, as the Danish Business authority is considering developing a 'privacy compass' and possibly a certification scheme for Danish businesses. The Danish Business authority is increasingly concerned by data protection issues, as it has become a critical topic for the export of services to Germany, and one possible approach is to establish a certification scheme / agree with Germany on mutual recognition of data protection certification schemes. She supports a European approach to the issue

I informed that COM may only start concrete work on privacy seals after the data protection reform is adopted, as it will provide the adequate harmonised framework for such certifications across the EU.

She informed that unfortunately there is little interest from the Danish government in the DP reform —"they don't understand it".
