Both for MON 1445 and MON 531, it is indicated that Food produced from MON1445/MON531 cotton (cottonseed oil) has an expiration date of 18/12/2011, however, that scope has been covered in the pending renewal application. Is there a possibility to correct the information on the website?

Secondly, we were concerned that the MON 810 pollen public commenting period extended beyond the indicated date. Last week, it was still open. Now, I see that the commenting period has ended, but the title under 'Closed consultations (2012)' is not accurate. It says MON 87460, where it should say MON 810. Is it possible to also correct there?
