As explained at the Novel Food working group meeting on 17 January 2018, according to our lawyers, the sanctioning of infringements of the obligation to market only approved novel foods is linked to the Union list. That means, we had to wait for the establishment of the Union list before starting the national legislative procedure. This procedure takes in Germany approximately six months. So we expect being able to notify the national penalty rules on the new Novel Food Regulation to the Commission mid this year.

Unfortunately, the draft Ordinance cannot be disclosed at this stage.

Apart from that, our Federal States, which are competent for food control in Germany, can take action in case of infringements based on their administrative law.
