Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref GestDem No 2018/1474

We refer to your e-mail dated 07/03/2018 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 9/3/2017 under the above-mentioned reference number.

You asked for "all documents related to the 23 April 2015 meeting between Eduard Hulicius and LEGO System A/S and Toy Industries of Europe (TIE), including but not limited to minutes, verbatim reports, e-mails, and presentations".

We regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application. Mr Hulicius confirmed that no report of that meeting was drafted as the subject of it (Bisphenol-A ban in France) had no direct relation to our portfolio but rather GROW (Reach) and SANTE (health safety) as he informed the interlocutors.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by this DG I am not in a position to handle your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
