Subject: Your letter (15L369) dated 01.09.2015 on study on actual GHG data for diesel, petrol, kerosene and natural gas

Dear representatives of the European gas industry,

Thank you for your letter dated 1st of September suggesting a greater involvement from your organisations in studies and discussions on greenhouse gas emissions from natural and renewable gases.

I welcome your suggestion since indeed we need reliable data directly from the industry in all aspects of production, transportation and use of natural and renewable gases.

Concerning the "Study on actual GHG data for diesel, petrol kerosene and natural gas" I would like to clarify that this was a tender contract and as such it did not allow for extensive direct consultations with stakeholders. Actually the workshop of 8 July 2015 was not foreseen by the tender Terms of Reference; it was an initiative of the contractor and the responsible unit (C2) in my Directorate – General in order to obtain feedback from the stakeholders. In annex you can find some more explanations on the data acquisition from the contractor.

I am informed that a meeting has been scheduled for the week of 20 November between the responsible unit, the contractor and yourselves.

I therefore take the opportunity to invite you to provide to the Commission and the contractor actual data from natural gas operations.
