As you may have heard from someone in your team (we actually met many of you :) ), we are currently working on the Brussels DisInfolab September event. Due to the workload, we are reducing (a little) our ambitions and are now mostly looking into an experience sharing session.

Our goal is to connect the numerous ongoing initiatives to each other, and also to use the local developers/coders community in order to create a common framework on how to fight disinformation processes which are currently jeopardizing liberal values in the western world.

The event will be held on **September 14 at The Aim** (Rue de la cible 50, in Schaerbeek, Brussels), from 3 PM to 10 PM with two main sessions:

- **One sharing of experience session** (3PM to 6 PM), during which we want to put forward different initiatives taken by various stakeholders using different techniques : identify fake news, source fake news, fact check fake news, spread real news.
- **One network building session** (6 PM to 8 PM) during which we will bring different solutions/initiatives together with the developers/coders/local community and try to ignite collaborations within the disinfo lab.

We will conclude the event with a networking drink.
