Please note that these reports, originating from three Member States, are disclosed for information only. They do not reflect the position of the Commission and cannot be quoted as such.

Concerning your request for access to the list of beneficiaries of the AMIF in Italy for the period 2014-2018, we regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold a document that would correspond to the description given in your application.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that, no such document corresponding to the description given in your application is held by the Commission, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil a part of your request related to the list of beneficiaries of the AMIF in Italy for the period 2014-2018.
