- V. Proposal for a Council Regulation fixing for 2019 the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks, applicable in Union waters and, for Union fishing vessels, in certain non Union waters
 - Continuation of examination
 - 1. The Working Party continued the examination of the proposal in particular the content of the Commission non papers as set out in docs.14959/18, 14960/18 and 14963/18. The Working Party also examined the document containing a summary of delegations' comments¹ (the "bible").
 - 2. <u>Delegations</u> entered scrutiny reservations as for the content of the non papers and made additional remarks for inclusion in the revised version of the bible.
 - 3. <u>The Presidency</u> concluded that the Working Party had examined the "bible", informed delegations that a revised version would be issued shortly and announced that the Working Party would revert to this item at its next session.
