Recently, during the Article 17 TFEU Dialogue "The Discrimination and Persecution of Non-Believers around the World", which was held at the European Parliament on 11 April 2018, you have met and briefly spoke with my colleague, Mr. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] at the European Jewish Association.

Our organization unites dozens of Jewish communities and thousands of members across Europe, with the main goal of not only defending their

rights and legitimate interests, but also promoting mutual understanding and productive coexistence between the members of different religious groups inhabiting our common and beloved European home.
