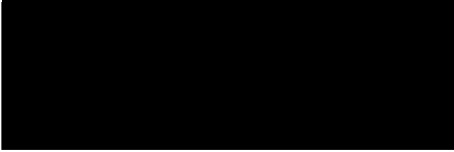

We communicated earlier this year about your availability to have an exchange of views with Insurance Europe's Executive Committee members. Unfortunately the date we proposed at that time did not work for you and I am reverting to you now to see if such an exchange might be possible at our upcoming Executive Committee meeting on Thursday, 27 September in Brussels.

Our Executive Committee is composed of the Director Generals of the national insurance associations and is [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The idea would be to have a breakfast meeting from 8h30 to 9h30 at our offices (rue Montoyer 51, 1000 Brussels) to have a broad dialogue about the EU regulatory agenda and its impact on the insurance industry. Traditionally, the guest speaker provides a 5-10 minute introduction, which is then followed by a question and answer session.

There are a number of key Commission initiatives in which our members have huge interest. These include the capital markets union, work on the Solvency II reviews, the sustainable finance agenda, the PEPP initiative and the review of the Motor Insurance Directive. Other issues of interest include digitalisation as well as work on the global insurance capital standard.
