Dear Mr Bossev,

By E-mail of 22 August 2019 you asked for: 'Copy of all the written notifications (as mentioned in art. 63-4 from Regulation (EC) 1013/2006) sent by the Bulgarian authorities to EC'.

By E-mail of the following day, the ENV ACCESS DOCUMENTS team asked for your clarifications of the scope of your request in order to handle with it. Until now you have not provided any answer.


In meantime, I noticed that you have not indicated any postal address. Since 1st April 2014, the postal address became a mandatory feature for the purpose of introducing a request for access to documents. The decision to ask for a postal address from applicants for access to documents was triggered inter alia by the need to direct the Commission's resources to those requests which have been filed by "real" applicants.

Therefore, I invite you to provide your postal address and clarifications of the scope of your request to the following E-mail address:
