This contract sets out the obligations of the parties during and after the duration of this contract.

EXCEPT ITS TENDER ARE HELD INAPPLICABLE, UNLESS EXPLICITLY MENTIONED IN THE SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THIS CONTRACT. IN ALL CIRCUMSTANCES, IN THE EVENT OF CONTRADICTION BETWEEN THIS CONTRACT AND DOCUMENTS ISSUED BY THE CONTRACTOR, THIS CONTRACT PREVAILS, REGARDLESS OF ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY IN THE CONTRACTOR'S DOCUMENTS.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

I.1. ORDER OF PRIORITY OF PROVISIONS

If there is any conflict between different provisions in this contract, the following rules must be applied:

- (a) The provisions set out in the special conditions take precedence over those in the other parts of the contract.
- (b) The provisions set out in the general conditions take precedence over those in the other annexes.
- (c) The provisions set out in the Annex I take precedence over those in the Annex II.

1.2. SUBJECT MATTER

The subject matter of the contract is **Trial of Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) for** long endurance Maritime Aerial Surveillance, Lot 1.

1.3. ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION

- 1.3.1 The contract enters into force on the date on which the last party signs it.
- 1.3.2 The performance of the contract cannot start before its entry into force.
- 1.3.3 The duration of the *performance of the contract* must not exceed 12 months. *Performance of the contract* starts from the date of entry into force of the contract. The period of *performance of the contract* may be extended only with the express written agreement of the parties before the expiration of such period.

I.4. PRICE

1.4.1. Price of the contract and maximum amount

The maximum net price payable under this contract is EUR 4,750,000.00 [four million seven hundred fifty thousand euro], in accordance with the financial offer of the contractor (Annex II).

I.4.2. Price revision index

Price revision is not applicable to this contract.

I.4.3. Reimbursement of expenses

Reimbursement of expenses is not applicable to this contract.

I.5. PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

I.5.1. Pre-financing

Pre-financing is not applicable to this contract.

1.5.2. Interim payment

- 1. The contractor may claim an interim payment after completion of each (except the last one) of the foreseen in respective Lot 100-hours-blocks of Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) services for long endurance maritime aerial surveillance. The contractor must send an invoice for that interim payment accompanied by the evidence required in the Annex I point 6.5 and accepted by Frontex.
- 2. The contracting authority must approve any submitted documents or deliverables and pay the claimed interim payment within 60 days from the day of receipt of the invoice.
- 3. If the contracting authority has observations to make, it must send them to the contractor and suspend the time limit for interim payment in accordance with Article II.21.7. The contractor has 15 days to submit additional information or corrections or a new version of the documents if the contracting authority requires it.
- 4. The contracting authority must give its approval and pay within the remainder of the timelimit indicated in point 2 above unless it rejects partially or fully the submitted documents or deliverables.

1.5.3. Payment of the balance

1. The contractor may claim the payment of the balance (for the last one of the foreseen in respective Lot 100-hours-blocks) following the requirements of the Annex I, point 6.5.7, as well as in accordance with Article II.21.6.

The contractor must send an invoice for payment of the balance due under the contract as provided for in the tender specifications, accompanied by the evidence required in the Annex I point 6.5 and accepted by Frontex.

- 2. The contracting authority must approve the submitted documents or deliverables and pay within 60 days from receipt of the invoice.
- 3. If the contracting authority has observations to make, it must send them to the contractor and suspend the time limit for payment in accordance with Article II.21.7.

The contractor has 15 days to submit additional information or corrections or a new version of the documents if the contracting authority requires it.

4. The contracting authority must give its approval and pay within the remainder of the timelimit indicated in point 2 above unless it rejects partially or fully the submitted documents or deliverables.

I.9. DATA CONTROLLER

1.10. EXPLOITATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE CONTRACT

1.11. TERMINATION BY EITHER PARTY

Either party may, terminate the contract by sending *formal notification* to the other party with one month written notice.

If the contract is terminated:

(a) neither party is entitled to compensation;

(b) the contractor is entitled to payment only for the services provided before termination takes effect; in case of termination by Frontex, the contractor may claim flying hours costs + fixed costs; in case of termination by the contractor, it may claim flying hours costs only.

- **1.12.1.** The contract is governed by Union law, complemented, where necessary, by the law of Poland. This is without prejudices to the application of the relevant EU MSs law to be followed during the implementation of the contract.
- **1.12.2.** The courts of Poland have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute regarding the interpretation, application or validity of the contract.
