We refer to your email dated 13.10.2019, in which you make a request for access to documents, registered under the above-mentioned reference number.

You request access to documents which contain the following information:

- documents or information about guidance applicable to them, provisions on their exclusivity or prevention of the potential conflicts of interest, taking into account their involvement in their own medical practices for the purpose of individual patients, their parallel employment or participation (current or previous) in other health establishment or membership in professional or lobbying association

Your application is currently being handled. However, we will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days, which expires on 14/11/2019.
