Dear Mr Schindler.

We refer to your e-mail dated 5 June 2020 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 10 June 2020 under the above-mentioned reference number.

You requested access to a "copy of each Access to Documents request from 2018 and 2019 that was refused registration because the requesting person did not provide a postal address".

In order to register and handle the requests of access to documents, the applicants that do not provide a postal address in their initial reply are invited to do so. Having conducted a thorough research, DG CLIMA did not identify any request that was not registered because the applicant did not provide a postal address.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Commission, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
