I. DRAFT ANNOTATED AGENDA

1. Issues relating to the signature and ratification of the ATT by EU Member States

- (i) *Council Decision authorising the signature and signature plans of EU Member States*

Delegations will exchange views on their signature of the ATT in the wake of the adoption of the Council decision authorising the signature. Opportunity will be provided to address where relevant the issues of provisional application of the Treaty (art.23) and reservations (art.25).

- (ii) *Signing ceremony*

Delegations will have the opportunity to provide updated information relating to the signing ceremony, notably on their level of representation.

- (iii) *Council Decision authorising the ratification*

Delegations will be informed on the next steps and related issues regarding the draft Council Decision authorising the ATT ratification.

2. Further outreach activities in support of the ATT process

- (i) *Council Decision 2013/43/CFSP in support of the ATT process*

Delegations will be updated on the second seminar under Council Decision 2013/43/CFSP and will discuss related issues (cf. meeting documents circulated ahead of the meeting).

(ii) *Other outreach activities*

Delegations will be invited to exchange information on any other outreach activities they took part to or plan to participate in.

3. Possible new Council Decision in support of effective implementation of the ATT

Based on comments received (cf. DELETED/085/13) and additional meeting documents to be circulated ahead of the meeting, delegations will revert to possible further EU activities on ATT implementation support.

4. Contacts with third countries and other stakeholders

(i) *Delegations will be invited to share information on recent consultations on ATT with third countries.*

(ii) *Possible EU demarche in support of the ATT signature*

Delegations will discuss the possibility of forthcoming EU demarches towards selected third countries.
