I. DRAFT ANNOTATED AGENDA

1. Issues relating to the ratification of the ATT by EU Member States

(i) Council decision authorising the ratification

The Group will address the state of play of the draft Council decision authorising the ratification in the wake of the request for consent of the European Parliament forwarded by the Council on 22 July 2013.

(ii) Issue of interpretative declarations

The Group will revert to the issue of possible interpretative declarations, notably with regard to article 7&3 of the ATT.

Further to the discussion and comments from the September meeting, the Group will discuss the revised draft of the Council Decision in support of the ATT implementation (cf. MD 45 REV 1/2013).

The Group will be updated on the Resolution on the ATT in the UNGA first committee.

5. Contacts with third countries and other stakeholders

(i) *EU demarche in support of the ATT signature*

The Group will be informed on the state of play of the EU demarche in support of the ATT signature (cf. EAS/1175/13).

(ii) *information-sharing on recent consultations with third countries*

Delegations will be invited to share information on recent consultations on ATT with third countries, including in the framework of the UNGA leaders week.
