Please note that your request was split between two Directorates-General (Directorate-General Communication Networks, Content and Technologies and the Secretariat-General).

This reply relates only to the documents under the responsibility of the Secretariat-General, i.e. those concerning possible meetings between Executive Vice-President Vestager and her Cabinet and the external entities listed above on the Digital Services Act.
