

Report on meeting with Huawei, 30 September 2020

On the initiative of Huawei, on 30 September Mr Kim Jorgensen, Head of Cabinet for EVP Vestager met with [REDACTED], Huawei Europe. [REDACTED] of Cabinet Vestager and [REDACTED] from the Secretariat General also participated in the meeting.

Huawei informed of its activities in Europe and concerns about the effects of measures adopted by the U.S., including for supply chains and consumers.

Huawei gave its views on competition in the 5G market and on the Open-RAN model.

On the toolbox for 5G security, Huawei expressed support for the EU's intention and efforts to mitigate the risks while raising concerns about fragmented implementation by EU Member States.

Huawei expressed their commitment to the cooperation on standardisation for 6G and emphasised the role of research programmes and ICT standard-setting bodies.

Huawei called for international cooperation on standards on data security and for a rulebook to be developed at the multilateral level.

Mr Jorgensen took note of the points made by the company and briefly mentioned the outcomes of the first EU-China High-level digital dialogue on 10 September 2020.
