GNI has engaged with policy and law makers in the Commission, at the Parliament, and on the Council on initiatives such as the proposed Terrorist

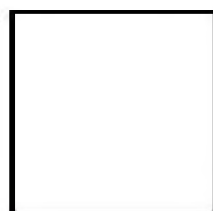

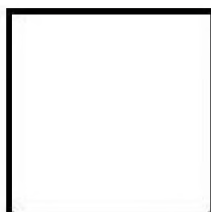
