As mentioned during the latest meeting of the TECH ESG, the EDPS is preparing to issue an Opinion on the Proposal for an Interim Regulation on the processing of personal and other data for the purpose of combatting child sexual abuse, which provides for a temporary derogation from Article 5(1) and Article 6 of the ePrivacy Directive.
