Thanks for reaching out. The roundtable of Wednesday is being organised because the Commissioner considers it important to have a final round of talks before finalising the texts of such an important reform of the regulation of the internet. As you might have seen he spoke already to a group of tech and he wants to hear also from civil society, consumers, HR advocates.

Given the format we won't have time for a discussion on details - we will certainly have the chance after the adoption of the texts.

He generally asks what you would expect would change for people, what problems you expect to be solved after DSA/DMA are adopted.

Regarding a call, I'm afraid I won't have the time before Wednesday, as my schedule is completely absorbed by the finalisation process. Would it be ok if we plan a discussion after the adoption and after you've seen the proposals? In the meantime, the team is at your disposal.
