Subject: Your access to documents request - GestDem 2021/4300

Dear Member of the European Parliament,
Dear Mr Breyer,

We refer to your email of 16 June 2021 wherein you introduced a request for access to documents, registered on 29 June 2021 under the above-mentioned reference number. As you were informed by email of 29 June 2021 (reference Ares(2021)4238317), your request for access to documents has been split between different services/Directorates-General of the Commission regarding the handling of your application, notably between the Directorate-General for Migration and Home Affairs (DG HOME), GestDem 2021/3942, the Directorate-General for Justice and Consumers (DG JUST), GestDem 2021/4299, and the Directorate-General for Communications Networks, Content and Technology (DG CONNECT), GestDem 2021/4300. This reply relates only to GestDem 2021/4300 and to documents held by DG CONNECT. We also make reference to our holding reply, dated 7 July 2021 (our reference Ares(2021)4416660), whereby we informed you that the time limit for handling your application GestDem 2021/4300 was extended by 15 working days pursuant to Article 7(3) of Regulation 1049/2001.

By your application, you requested access to the following:

‘Under the right of access to documents in the EU treaties, as developed in Regulation 1049/2001, I am requesting access to

- the full text of all Codes of Conduct and "Crisis Protocols" (e.g. "EU Crisis Protocol") which Internet service providers have agreed on/to.’

We have identified the following document as falling within the scope of your request:

- EU Code of Practice on Disinformation
